Wes Bryan serves as the Environment, Safety, Health & Quality (ESH&Q) Director, for Savannah River Mission Completion, LLC, (SRMC), which is conducting operations at the Department of Energy's (DOE) Savannah River Site (SRS) near Aiken, S.C. In this role, Mr. Bryan leads efforts to continue the site's positive safety culture program and fosters ESH&Q programs that support field execution.

Mr. Bryan has over 30 years of experience in project management, operations, maintenance, radiological controls, waste management, and emergency management, as well as extensive knowledge of all liquid waste facilities and processes. At multiple sites across the Department of Energy complex, he has served in numerous leadership roles including Radiological Control Manager, Operations Manager, Facility Manager, and Vice President and Plant Manager.

In his most recent position as the President and Project Manager of Washington River Protection Solutions, he led the Tank Operations Contract focused on ongoing cleanup effort at DOE's Hanford Site. This included overseeing the safe and efficient management, retrieval, and pretreatment of radioactive and chemical tank waste.

Before joining WRPS, Mr. Bryan was the Director of the Defense Waste Processing Facility (DWPF) and Saltstone Facilities for Savannah River Remediation. In this role, he successfully led the planning, management, integration, operation, and maintenance of DWPF, Saltstone, and Glass Waste Storage Buildings in the completion of mission goals in a safe, compliant, and efficient manner. He also completed two previous tours of duty at SRS, beginning as a Radiological Control Inspector and progressing to increasing roles of responsibilities across many of the facilities at SRS. Mr. Bryan also completed a six-year assignment at the Waste Isolation Pilot Plan in Carlsbad, NM, as well as a two-year assignment at the Advanced Mixed Waste Treatment Plan in Idaho Falls, Idaho.

Mr. Bryan resides in Graniteville, S.C., with his wife and daughter and has two boys living in Salt Lake City, UT.
